

## The Fall

In Genesis 3, the fall of man involves his refusal to respond to God's word and to enter the relationship in which he can fulfil the purpose for which he was created. Man seeks to find within himself the justification for his existence (Rom. 10:3). Rather than to enter into a covenant Relationship with God and other men where he can reflect God's image and glory, he tries to find the meaning of his purpose with the created world around him in the context of his immediate surrounding (Rom. 1:25). The result is, his life becomes a living nightmare of bondages.





Due to the seperation of the relationship between man and God it has lead man into six major bondages that directly or indirectly hender his return back to God:

- 1. Conflict with One's Self
- 2. Frailty & Frustration
- 3. Perverted & Evil Thoughts in Your Mine
- 4. The Lack of Humility
- 5. The Lust Factor
- 6. The Desire of Gain



The Road to Restoration!

- A. Face reality; looking at who you are, what you are and where you're going!
- B. Humble yourself before Jesus and others!
- C. Admit that you are a sinner! (Rom. 3:23)
- D. Repent of your sin against God! (1 John. 1:8-9, Lu. 13:3)
- E. Beliveve that Jesus died for your sins! (John. 3:16)
- F. Be baptize in the name of Jesus! (Act. 2:38)
- G. Confess that Jesus is your Lord! (Rom.10:9-10,
