

How **FEAR** is formed through subjugation!



What is **Fear**, and its main components and attributes.

- Fear** :1. a. A very unpleasant or disturbing feeling caused by the presence or imminence of danger: *Our fears intensified as the storm approached.*
- ▶ b. A state or condition marked by this feeling: *living in constant fear of attack; saved as much as he could for fear of losing his job.*
 - ▶ 2. A feeling of disquiet or apprehension: *a fear of looking foolish.*
 - ▶ 3. A reason for dread or apprehension: *Being alone is my greatest fear.*
 - ▶ 4. Extreme reverence or awe, as toward a deity.

- ▶ In the Bible, the word of God reads in the book of 2 Timothy 1:7
- ▶ ⁷ For God hath not given us the spirit of **fear**; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

So we can see that **fear** is not just an emotion, but it is a **spirit**.

So what type of **spirit** is it? Is it good or is it bad?

As we look a little closer we can see what attributes are inside of **fear**:
apprehension, stress, anger, insecurity, defeat, cowardice, **fright**,
dread, **terror**, **horror**, **panic**, **alarm**.

What is the fertile soil that is needed in you or your life for the seed of **Fear** to thrive?

- ▶ Just like anything else, it's like growing things in a greenhouse or on a farm. In order to have a good crop of any type, you need fertile soil that has nutrients, but most of all, water.
- ▶ In much the same way, **Fear** needs the same things that will nurture it. The following chart will show you the break down of the things that will create the fertile and ripe soil or conditions for roots of **Fear** to thrive.
